## Annual Report 2006-07 Central Zoo Authority

### An Introduction:

The Central Zoo Authority is a statutory autonomous body under the administrative control of the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India. The Central Zoo Authority was established in February, 1992 through an amendment in the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972 (1991 Amendment). The main objective was to enforce minimum standards and norms for upkeep and health care of animals in Indian Zoos, to provide them technical and other assistance for improvement and to restrain mushrooming of unplanned and ill-conceived Zoos that were cropping up as adjuncts to public parks, industrial complexes and waysides. The Central Zoo Authority has completed 15 years in the year 2007. In the last 15 years, the Central Zoo Authority has made much headway in achievement of most of its mandated targets. The Recognition of Zoo Rules were formulated in the very first year of its establishment i.e. 1992, for fixing up the standards and norms for management of Zoos in the country. To give proper direction to the Zoos in the country National Zoo Policy was framed and adopted in the year 1998. Guidelines for better housing, upkeep and health care of animals in the Zoos have been prescribed and distributed. Till date the Central Zoo Authority has received 509 applications from different Zoos/ animal housing facilities for grants of recognition as Zoos under

Section 38H of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972. This includes the applications from rescue centres and circuses which also have been brought under the definition of Zoo in the 2002 amendment of the Wild Life (Protection) Act. All the applications have been scrutinized and/or facilities physically evaluated for prescribed standards and norms under the Recognition of Zoo Rules, 1992. Out of 509 applications, 169 facilities (19 large, 11 medium, 29 small, 77 mini, 12 rescue centres and 21 circuses) have been recognized as Zoos (detail are placed at **Annexure - I**). 340 facilities have either been refused recognition or de-recognized as Zoos after following the prescribed procedure (detail of the de-recognized/ refused recognition animal holding facilities is given at **Annexure - II**). 264 animal holding facilities (refused recognition/ de-recognized as Zoos) have already been closed and all the animals from these have either been rehabilitated or phased out through control on breeding. Action to rehabilitate around 4000 animals with remaining 76 animals holding facilities (but no more functioning as Zoos i. e. displaying the animals) is contemplated.

The Central Zoo Authority has provided a total of Rs. 118.32 crores to different recognized public sector Zoos in the country for improvement of animal housing, veterinary care and development of infrastructure in the last 15 years (details are enclosed at **Annexure - III**). Seven rescue centres





have been created by the Central Zoo Authority at Chennai, Bangalore, Tirupati, Visakhapatnam, Bhopal, Jaipur and South Khairbari, West Bengal for rehabilitation of lions, tigers, leopards, bears and monkeys, whose performance has been banned in the Circuses. 367 lions and tigers and other animals have been rehabilitated in these rescue centres. The maintenance of these Rescue Centres, including feeding of animals is the committed responsibility of Government of India through Central Zoo Authority. Upgrading the professional skills of the Zoo personnel has always been the area of high priority for the Authority. So far 145 Zoo Directors, 14 Zoo Veterinarians, 153 middle level Zoo personnels/ Supervisors and more than 800 Zoo keepers have been trained by the Central Zoo Authority by organizing short term training programmes. 18 Zoo Directors, 13 Zoo Veterinarians and 1 Supervisor have received advance training at Durrell Wildlife Conservation Trust, U.K. Around 14 national/ international workshops and seminars have been organized by the Central Zoo Authority in the last 15 years.

Based on the above progress/ advances made, more confident Central Zoo Authority has very recently signed MoU with some national institutions to initiate studies in different areas of Zoo management. The School of Planning & Architecture, New Delhi, Centre for Environmental Education, Ahmedabad, Indian Veterinary Research Institute, Bareilly, Wildlife Institute of India, Dehradun and Centre for Cellular & Molecular Biology, Hyderabad are working on different related aspects to help Zoos

in better and scientific management. A Laboratory for Conservation of Endangered Species (LaCONES) has also been created at Hyderabad and dedicated to the Nation by Hon'ble President of India Dr. A. P. J. Abdul Kalam on 1<sup>st</sup> February, 2007 to provide biotechnological inputs for scientific management of Zoos. The Central Zoo Authority is also providing funds in the form of small grant fellowship to the Zoos to organize studies to address the local issues related to ex-situ wildlife conservation at the Zoo level. Nine such programmes are in progress in different Zoos at the moment. The Central Zoo Authority has also taken up conservation breeding of critically endangered wild animal species in Indian Zoos in more scientific and organized way. Coordinated conservation breeding of more than four dozen such species has been adopted and taken up under the programme. After the orders issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in 2001, no new Zoo can be initiated in the country without prior permission of the Central Zoo Authority and Hon'ble Supreme Court. The Central Zoo Authority has approved creation of only two such facilities in last seven years whereas more than 14 Zoos are in process of relocation in bigger areas or being created denovo on the same locations as per master insert layout plan approved by the Central Zoo Authority.

The Central Zoo Authority was last reconstituted for a period of three years in September, 2004 vide Gazette Notification No. S.O. 976(E) dated 1.9.2004 and appointed the following to it, namely,

To carry out the functions of the Authority, two Committee, namely Administrative Committee (headed by the Director General of Forests, Government of India - to decide on administrative and budgetary issues) and Technical Committee (headed by the Addl. DGF(WL) - to take decisions on all technical matters) coterminous with the tenure of the Authority have also been constituted. Three Sub-Committees, namely, Sub-Committee on Zoo Designing; Sub-Committee on Conservation Breeding and Sub-Committee on Research have also been created involving experts to give suggestions and recommendations on new initiatives and technical issues taken up by the Central Zoo Authority from time to time.

The functions assigned to the Authority under the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972 are:

- (a) to specify the minimum standards for housing, upkeep and veterinary care of the animals kept in zoos;
- (b) to evaluate and assess the functioning of the zoos with respect to the prescribed standards or norms;
- (c) to recognise or derecognise zoos;
- (d) to identify endangered species of wild animals for purposes of captive breeding and assigning responsibility in this regard to a zoo;
- (e) to coordinate the acquisition, exchange and loaning of animals for breeding purpose;
- (f) to ensure maintenance of studbooks of endangered species of wild animals bred in captivity;

- (g) to identify priorities and the es with regard to display of captive animals in zoos;
- (h) to coordinate training of zoo personnel in India and outside India;
- (i) to coordinate research in captive breeding and educational programmes for the purposes of zoos;
- (j) to provide technical and other assistance to zoos for their proper management and development on scientific lines;
- (k) to perform such other functions as may be necessary to carry out the purposes of this Act with regard to zoos.

The last (XX<sup>th</sup>) meeting of the Authority was held on 22.2.2006. The approval of the Annual Report and Statement of Accounts of the Authority for the year 2005-06 was got approved by circulation from the Members of the Authority.

The Administrative Committee of the Central Zoo Authority met on 29.09.2006 and 27.02.2007. Budget estimate for the year 2007-08 along with revised estimates for the year 2006-07 and proposal for revised EFC for XI<sup>th</sup> Five Year Plan for Central Zoo Authority were approved and adopted in the meetings.

The Technical Committee met twice during the year i.e. on 21.7.2006 and 23.1.2007 and considered the recommendations made by the Sub-Committees on Zoo Designing, Conservation Breeding and Research in addition to attending to other technical issues.





## Prescribing standards and norms

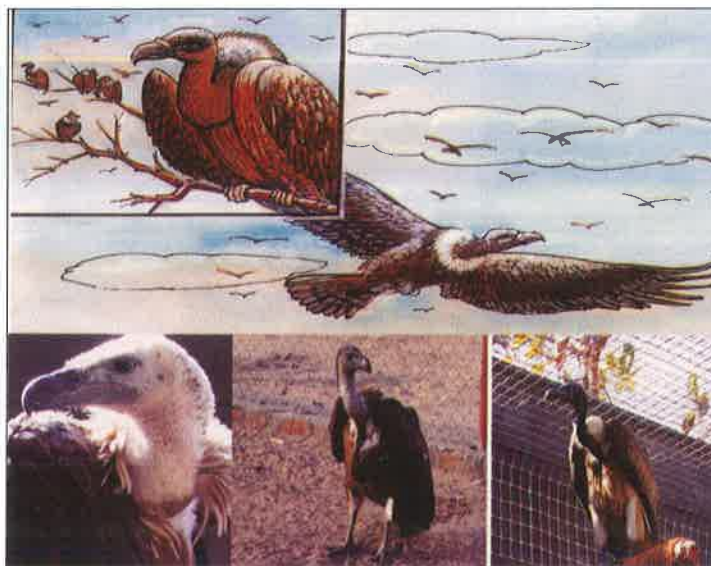
The Technical Committee of the Central Zoo Authority in its 44<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 23<sup>rd</sup> January, 2007 discussed and adopted the guidelines for modern and better barrier designs for different Zoo animals. The guidelines were circulated to the Zoos for use. The Technical Committee also decided to finance enrichment and furnishing of animal enclosures in the Zoos in the same meeting. The guidelines and conditions for compliance in the Circuses as Zoos have also been formulated and circulated. Guidelines to deal with the cases of avian influenza in Zoo animals have also been finalized with assistance from Indian Veterinary Research Institute, Bareilly and distributed to all Zoos. Proceedings of training programme on Master Planning of Zoos organized at Bhubaneswar were brought out and distributed to the Zoos, related organizations and individuals.

## Evaluation of Zoos

Three large, two medium, seven small and sixteen mini Zoos, thirteen rescue centres and one circus were evaluated as Zoos during the year. The list of Zoos evaluated during the year 2006-07 is placed at **Annexure – IV**. The site inspections for the creation of a Night Safari at Greater Noida in Uttar Pradesh and Lion Safari at Etawah in Uttar Pradesh were conducted. Both the locations have been given in principle approval for creation of the facilities subject to the necessary orders from the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

## Recognition/ de-recognition of Zoos

Recognitions to five large, four medium, fifteen small, thirty-four mini Zoos, five rescue centres and 21 Circuses (total 84 Zoos) have been given, whereas, recognition have been suspended or refused for 35 mini Zoos,

23 rescue centres and 4 circuses. Details of different categories of Zoos recognised or refused recognition as Zoos during the year 2006-07 is placed at **Annexure - Va & Vb.**

### **Conservation Breeding Programme**

The Sub-Committee on Conservation Breeding met on 16.07.2006 and again on 29.11.2006 during the year and discussed different proposals. A three days Workshop was organized at Vulture Conservation and Breeding Centre, Pinjore to finalize the details for the ex-situ conservation breeding of Vultures namely; White back vulture, Slender billed vulture, Long billed vulture in Indian Zoos. The Workshop was conducted in collaboration with Wildlife Institute of

India and Bombay Natural History Society. Directors from the Zoos at Junagarh, Bhopal, Bhubaneswar and Hyderabad attended the Workshop in addition to the Chief Wild Life Wardens of the concerned State and representatives from WII, BNHS, Zoological Society of London and RSPB U.K. It was decided that each Zoo will be provided Rs. 41.0 lakhs each for creation of off-display breeding centres at these locations.

A meeting of the Chief Wild Life Wardens and Directors/ In-charge of the Zoos from North-eastern States was organized at Guwahati on 17<sup>th</sup>-18<sup>th</sup> March, 2007 to decide about the endangered species from North-eastern region needed to be taken up under the Conservation Breeding Programme in the Zoos of the region.

A proposal for further release of two male and one female Red panda from the captive stock of Padmaja Naidu Himalayan Zoological Park, Darjeeling into the Singalila National Park in Darjeeling Hills was approved. The proposals for initiation of conservation breeding programme for Hume's pheasant at Aizawl, Mouse deer at Hyderabad, Pangolin at Bhubaneswar and Painted roof turtle at Kukrail (Lucknow) were approved including creation of off-display conservation breeding centres.

### **Exchange/ transfer of animals by Zoos**

To bring greater transparency in the management of Zoos and facilitate exchange of animals for making viable social groupings, inventory of animals in Indian Zoos for the year 2005-06, giving details of species wise birth and details was compiled and published for distribution among Zoo managers, animal welfare organizations and other concerned institutions/ organizations. Twenty six exchange proposals of animals between Indian Zoos and four exchange proposals between Indian Zoos and foreign Zoos were approved by the Authority during the period of the report.

A list of births of endangered species in Indian Zoos during the year 2006-07 is given at **Annexure-VI**.

### **Maintenance of Studbooks**

In order to maintain the National Studbooks for all endangered species a Memorandum of Understanding has been signed with Wildlife Institute of India, Dehradun for 14 wild animal species for

which the conservation breeding programmes are in progress in Indian Zoos. The Central Zoo Authority had sanctioned Rs. 22.20 lakhs for creation of infrastructure, collection of information from the field and training of Zoo personnels in the Zoos to the Wildlife Institute of India under the programme. The project is for five years. Wildlife Institute of India has already started working on the project and it is expected that National Studbooks of the desired species will be ready for publication from the next financial year. The compiled data and the Studbooks under the programme will also be loaded on the website of the Central Zoo Authority as well as Wildlife Institute of India.

### **Theme/ Planning in Zoos**

The Sub-Committee on Zoo Designing of the Central Zoo Authority met on 6.7.2006 and again on 29.11.2006. The master (layout) plan for Zoos at Kota, Udaipur, Jaipur and Jodhpur in Rajasthan have been approved in the meetings. A format for preparation of master plans for Zoos was finalized and circulated to Zoos. Six day training programme for Zoo Directors/ In-charges on preparation of theme based master planning for Indian Zoos was organized at Bhubaneswar during the month of April, 2006. Master planning exercises for the smaller Zoos were organized at Darjeeling for the State of West Bengal and Hyderabad for the State of Andhra Pradesh.

### **Human Resource Development**

One week training programme for the Directors/ In-charges of the Zoo was

organized at Nandankanan Zoological Park, Bhubaneswar during April, 2006 in collaboration with Wildlife Institute of India, Dehradun. The training programme for Zoo Veterinarians was organized at Bareilly from 5<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> March, 2007 in collaboration with Indian Veterinary Research Institute, Izatnagar. Two weeks training programme for middle level Zoo personnel was organized at Arignar Anna Zoological Park, Chennai from 9<sup>th</sup> to 18<sup>th</sup> November, 2006. Wildlife Institute of India coordinated the training programme. Short term training programmes for Zoo keepers were organized at Kanpur, Bhubaneswar, Mysore, Ahmedabad and Guwahati on regional basis in regional languages. Special training programme for Zoo keepers of the high altitude Zoos was also organized at Padmaja Naidu Himalayan Zoological Park, Darjeeling during the year.

Three days workshop-cum training programme for the participating Zoos in Vulture Conservation Breeding

Programme was organized at Vulture Rescue and Breeding Centre, Pinjore from 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> November, 2006. The representatives from Bombay Natural History Society, Wildlife Institute of India, RSPB and Zoological Society of London along with Chief Wild Life Wardens of the concerned states participated in the workshop. Two days workshop on conservation breeding husbandry of Hoolock Gibbon was organized at Guwahati on 17<sup>th</sup> & 18<sup>th</sup> March, 2007 where the Chief Wildlife Wardens and Directors of the Zoos from North-eastern States participated. One Zoo Director and one Zoo Veterinarian were sponsored by the Central Zoo Authority for three weeks training programme at Durrell Wildlife Conservation Trust, Jersey, UK sponsored by Central Zoo Authority. Member Secretary attended Annual CBSG & WAZA meetings at Halle/Leipzig, Germany. A technical paper on in-situ and ex-situ linkage - Red panda Conservation in Eastern Himalaya was presented by him in the WAZA meeting.



### Research

The Sub-Committee on Research met on 05.07.2006. The recommendations were placed in the meeting of the Technical Committee of the Authority held on 21.7.2006. A Memorandum of Understanding has been signed with Centre for Cellular & Molecular Biology/ LaCONES, Hyderabad for five year long research project to work on biotechnological interventions in conservation of endangered species in Indian Zoos. During the period the LaCONES will analyze the genetic health of the captive wild animals of desired species in Indian Zoos and establish frozen Zoo, and develop technologies/ expertise in the field of Assisted Reproduction (AR) for conservation breeding of endangered species facing problems with the breeding in captive conditions. Total approved cost of the project is Rs. 100.34 lakhs for five years. A study on standardization of animal diet in captive conditions has also been finalized with Indian Veterinary Research Institute, Bareilly. The award of maintenance of

National Studbooks of endangered wild animals species in Indian Zoos has been given to Wildlife Institute of India, Dehradun. The project is of five years. The total fund involvement is of Rs. 22.20 lakhs. The Zoo at Alipore, Kolkata has been given funds under small grant fellowships for preparing conservation breeding management plan for Thamin deer whereas Padmaja Naidu Himalayan Zoological Park, Darjeeling has been provided funds to work on behavioural study and enclosure enrichment for Himalayan black bear. Nandankanan Zoological Park, Bhubaneswar has been awarded studies to work on endo and ecto parasites in Zoo animals. The study is of three years duration, costing Rs. 6.00 lakhs. The Zoo at Darjeeling has again been asked to work on record keeping in Indian Zoos whereas Kanpur Zoo will be preparing disaster management plan for Indian Zoos under the small grant fellowship scheme. National Zoological Park, New Delhi has been provided funds for preparation of a manual on transport cages for wild animals.

### Improvement of Zoos

The Sub-Committee on Zoo Designing met twice during the year i.e. on 06.07.2006 and 29.11.2006. 24 designs for creation of new animal enclosures have been approved by the Sub-Committee on Zoo Designing in its meetings. The Technical Committee met twice i.e. on 21.7.2006 and 23.1.2007 and approved financial assistance worth Rs. 1456.784 lakhs for improvement of Zoos during the year. Seven rescue centres dealing with lions and tigers rescued from the Circuses have been provided Rs. 399.568 lakhs for their maintenance including animal feed during the year. Details of the grants released to different Zoos and other organisations during the year 2006-07 is given in **Annexure - VII.**

### Administrative Matters

The Central Zoo Authority is presently housed at Annexe-VI, Bikaner House, Shahjahan Road, New Delhi. There are 15 regular/ contractual scientific/ administrative personnel available to assist the Member Secretary in the discharge of his duties in the establishment of the Central Zoo Authority. The proposal for creation of one post of Evaluation and Monitoring Officer, one post of Scientific Officer, one post of Evaluation and Monitoring Assistant and one post of Technical Assistant on regular basis in the Authority is pending with Ministry of Finance, Government of India. ## Financial Matters

During the financial year 2006-07, the Central Zoo Authority received Rs. 20.865 crores as grants-in-aid from the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India. Out of the Rs. 18.41 crores was released as grants to different public sector recognised zoos and other organisation during the year.

The accounts of the Central Zoo Authority for the year 2006-07 have been compiled. The internal audit was assigned to a chartered accountant firm and the final audit of the accounts of the CZA has been conducted by Scientific Department of C.A.G. under Section 19(2) of G & AGs (Duties, Powers and Conditions of Service) Act, 1971 read with Section 38E(5) and (6) of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972. The audit report of the Chartered Accountant's firm and accounts was submitted to Principal Director of Audit, Scientific Department. The local audit party of the department conducted detailed audit of accounts of the Central Zoo Authority for the year 2006-07.

The copies of the accounts for the year 2006-07 containing receipts and payments accounts, income and expenditure accounts and balance sheet as on 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2007, with schedules are placed at **Annexure - VIII**.

## Other Activities carried out during last year

The Technical Committee in its 43<sup>rd</sup> meeting held on 21.7.2006 decided to create quarantine facilities for wild animals at four major metro cities in India i.e. at Delhi, Chennai, Mumbai and Kolkata. The Zoos in these metros have been requested to submit the proposal accordingly. The decision to establish a National Referral Centre for providing super specialty services and diagnostic facilities at Indian Veterinary Research Institute, Bareilly has been taken by the Authority.

The CZA had provided a set of 15 books related to Indian Wildlife, Veterinary Care and Management of Wild Animals in Captivity distributed to all recognised large, medium and small Zoos to the country.

A decision was also made to bring out the 5<sup>th</sup> volume of Indian Zoo Year book in the year, 2007. The Central Zoo Authority has also brought out the theme based Calendar, 2007. A Management Information System (MIS) has been developed in the Authority Office for more efficiency and transparency in the functioning of the Central Zoo Authority.

## **Audit Report on the Accounts of Central Zoo Authority, New Delhi for the year 2006-07**

### **Introduction**

The Central Zoo Authority (Authority), New Delhi was established in February, 1992 under Section 38A of the Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972. The Authority started functioning from 4<sup>th</sup> February, 1992. It is totally financed by grants and loans received from the Central Government. During the year 2006-2007, the Authority received grants of Rs. 20.63 crore from the Ministry of Environment & Forests, New Delhi, besides an unspent balance grant of Rs. 0.24 crore of previous year. Out of it, the Authority utilized a sum of Rs. 20.58 crore leaving a balance of Rs. 0.29 crore.

The Accounts of the Authority are audited by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under Section 19(2) of the Comptroller and Auditor General's (Duties, Powers and Conditions of Service) Act, 1971 read with section 38 (G) of the Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972 as amended.

### **Comments on Accounts**

#### **(2) Balance Sheet**

##### **2.1 Understatement of Assets**

The Ministry of Environment and Forest released Rs. 6.30 lakh to the Authority for organizing "International Conference on Vulture" against which the Authority spent Rs. 7.68 lakh during the year 2005-06. The excess expenditure of Rs. 1.38 lakh was yet to be reimbursed by the Ministry. The Authority had, however, not included the same in the Assets side in the Balance Sheet, as a result of which the assets were understated to the same extent.

### **General**

#### **3. Accounting policies and Notes to Accounts**

The authority had not disclosed the following in its accounting policy and notes on account:-

##### **3.1 1. Release of funds**

The amount released to the various zoos was accounted for as expenditure for the year in which the same was released, despite the fact that the amount so released might not be fully utilised towards the project during the accounting year.

##### **3.1.2. Non depiction of Superannuation fund**

The authority had been making contribution towards Superannuation Scheme



to the Life Insurance Corporation of India. An amount of Rs. 5.16 lakh was accumulated as of March 2007, but it was not disclosed in Notes on accounts.

### **3.2 Improper maintenance of Asset Register**

Assets Register is required to be maintained by the Grantee Institution in prescribed format. Test check of records revealed that Asset Registers were not maintained properly as neither the progressive totals were carried out nor the gross totals were carried out. In the absence of which the correctness of value of assets of Rs.15.57 lakh as depicted in the Balance Sheet could not be verified in Audit.

### **3.3 Physical Verification**

Physical Verification of assets had not been conducted since 2005-06 in the absence of which the correctness of the value of assets of Rs. 15.57 lakh as depicted in the Balance Sheet could not be verified in audit.

### **3.4 Non Depiction of total value of assets ( Gross Block) and Total depreciation (Gross Block)**

Schedule 8 of the Balance Sheet has not been correctly drawn. The total value of assets (Gross Block) and total depreciation upto beginning of the year were not depicted in the Schedule 8 of the Balance Sheet in the absence of which the total gross block of assets and depreciation were not verified in audit. CZA stated (December 2007) that it would take considerable time in working out total value of assets (Gross Block) and total depreciation (Gross block) and revising the schedule 8. However, the account ( 2007-08) of the authority will be prepared as per the guidelines
